

Staff Conference Travel Allocations

For SC27, we are using an allocation model for travel expenses. This approach is far simpler to manage, and will likely more than compensate staff for travel costs.

Each staff will receive a transfer of SC27 funding. Then the staff will arrange their travel, pay with a pcard, and charge it to their own account.

What the Allocation Covers

- Airfare or car travel
- Baggage fees
- Airport parking or transportation
- Half of rideshare costs between the airport and the Rosen Centre (expected to be split with other attendees)

As you are booking travel, you may want to consider flexible travel dates, alternate airports, or one-way tickets depending on the cost of flying.

**The SC27 team is keeping an eye on how travel prices are being affected by rising oil costs. We may send out separate communication to allocate additional funding if needed as we get closer to the conference time.

When to Arrive and When to Depart

Please plan flights to arrive no later than **3 pm** on January 2nd. You may depart anytime on January 6th, as there is no program schedule for that day.

Additional Travel Support for Western States

If your state is marked with an asterisk in the table, your allocation includes an additional 100 dollars to help with longer distance travel and time zone (represented in the chart below). If it helps your travel to come in on Jan 1 rather than 2, this will pay your share of the extra hotel night plus a meal.

Home State Coverage

Travel allocations are based on your **home state, not** where you happen to be traveling from. So, if you are on vacation or coming from another location, please use the amount listed for your home state. International staff should also use the allocation for their home state as well.
